The Acid Maltase Deficiency Association (AMDA) was formed in 1995 to assist in funding research and to promote public awareness of Acid Maltase Deficiency (also known as Pompe Disease). Pompe Disease is one of a family of 49 rare genetic disorders known as Lysosomal Storage Diseases or LSDs. It is also classified as a glycogen storage disease and known as Glycogen Storage Disease Type II. At one time AMD was a death sentence. Now, while there is a treatment there is still no cure.

Raising funds for an organization like the AMDA is difficult at best. The number of people impacted by this disease is relatively small (it affects 1 in 40,000) when compared to cancers and other conditions like heart disease or asthma. It is when that small number includes one of your own that it take on new meaning.

Since the first Pull for Pompe in April 2011, the PCMA of Texas has raised over \$600,000 for Pompe Disease Research. All of the money raised (after expenses) has been dedicated to funding the AMDA Research Grant. This Research Grant was re-named the Helen Walker Pompe Disease Research Grant in 2013 in memory of Helen Walker—a Pompe patient, advocate and dear friend from Australia who had dedicated her life to fighting for Pompe patients around the world.

Each year the AMDA solicits Research Grant applications from researchers who are dedicated to improving the lives of Pompe patients. With the support and advice of a Review Committee of experts from around the world, the AMDA evaluates all applications and selects the Project that will have the greatest impact on Pompe patients.
